TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Parent/guardian represents to Kids of Mount Sinai that the camper is in sound physical and mental health and fully able to participate in all Camp activities without need of individual or specialized attention or medical regimen and that the camper's health will not impinge or impact negatively on other campers or the Camp program.

Parent/guardian agrees to advise the Director promptly in writing of any change in the camper's physical or mental health between the date of enrollment and the start of the Camp season as well as throughout the camp season.

The parent/guardian who signs this contract is responsible for payment of all fees charged. Prior to 6/26/26 a 50% refund excluding registration fee will be given. After 6/26/26 all fees are non-transferable and non-refundable, excluding extended medical/health safety absences of more than 5 days (illness, injury, mandated quarantine). There will be no pro-rating or reduction of camp fees based on missed days due to medical/health safety shorter than 5 days. A doctor's note with an explanation will be required for extended absences of more than 5 days. Makeup days or a pro-rated refund will then be provided for those days missed due to medical/health safety more than 5 days.

Changes requested after camp begins may be done subject to availability. A \$50.00 Change Fee will apply. If a parent/guardian wishes to decrease the amount of time that he/she originally registered for, after camp begins, no refund will be given.

Kids of Mount Sinai shall have the right to make all decisions regarding a camper's fitness to participate in particular activities or the entire Camp program. Kids of Mount Sinai shall have the right to cancel this contract at any time if it determines that the physical, mental, or emotional condition of the child would prevent them from participating safely and satisfactorily in our program, interacting positively with other campers, or if a child's parent/guardian makes an unreasonable demand that cannot be satisfied within the Camp program. Should such action be taken no refund will apply.

Parent/guardian who signs this form authorizes Kids of Mount Sinai to release their child to either parent/guardian listed on this application (or persons authorized by a parent/guardian). The child will continue to be released to either parent/guardian unless directed by a court order to do otherwise. Disputes between parents involving the Camp in any way must be resolved immediately by the parents. Kids of Mount Sinai shall have the right to terminate this contract and dismiss the child if disputes between parents remain ongoing. Should such action be taken no refund will apply.

Parent/guardian gives permission for their child's picture (image only, no names/identification) to be used in printed publication, video, and online showing participation in Kids of Mount Sinai activities/programs.

Parent/guardian acknowledges that the summer 2026 camp program may be adjusted to accommodate federal/state/local guidelines and activities and events promoted prior may be revised, replaced, or cancelled due to scheduling, availability, weather, or other unanticipated causes.

Parent/guardian acknowledges that there are natural hazards associated with outdoor settings and risks associated with camp and group activities. Parent/guardian further acknowledges that Kids of Mount Sinai is not accountable for any illness/injury that may occur through no fault or negligence of their care, act of God, or communicable disease. In consideration of Kids of Mount Sinai accepting their child, and to the extent permitted and provided by State Law, parent/guardian agrees to release and discharge Kids of Mount Sinai, its agents and employees from all claims of liability for any damages or injuries which may be sustained while their child is at camp.
